- SERVICES:
- Counseling services.
 - Emergency Contraceptive Pills for prevention of pregnancy (must be done within 3 days [72 hours] after the incident);
 - Post Exposure Prophylaxis - Treatment for prevention of HIV/AIDS/ STDs (must be taken within 3 days [72 hours] after the incident.
 - Treatment of wounds and fractures.
 - Collecting of forensic evidence and information by filling in the PF3 form – by government health worker i.e. Doctor, Police, Clinical Officer or Midwife.
 - Primary Health Care, vaccination, management of SGBV cases, referral

- Case intake and management.
 - Help the survivor overcome trauma and social stigma
 - Mental health and psychosocial support.
 - Referral of cases

 - Physical protection of witnesses and survivors.

 - Referrals and case management

SAFETY AND SECURITY

ACTORS: Police, DISO, GISO, LC Is & Secretary for Defense, OPM, LWF, UNHCR, Prisons and RDC .

- SERVICES:
- Provide physical protection / Safe shelters.
 - Counseling.
 - Arrest of alleged perpetrators/suspects.
 - Issue Police Form (PF3, 3A, 24, 24A).
 - Gather evidence and complete file for case.
 - Inform survivors and witnesses on court hearing.
 - Community policing.
 - Ensuring safety and security of survivors & witnesses.
 - Follow up of cases.
